

About Today's Bible Readings

ISAIAH 2:1-5

The Lord's Day will bring instruction and peace to all peoples. That day will more than fulfill our Advent desires.

Responsorial Psalm: 122: 1-2, 3-4, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9

R. Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord.

ROMANS 13:11-14

Here is our Advent agenda: a way of life to match the times in which we live as we await the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

MATTHEW 24:37-44

We may know neither the day nor the hour, but one thing is certain: The Lord is coming. That fact should color all our thoughts and deeds.

ENTRANCE RITE – Psalm 25:1-3

- V. I wait for You, O Lord; I lift up my soul to my God. In You I trust; do not let me be disgraced; do not let my enemies gloat over me.
- R. No one is disgraced who waits for You, but only those who lightly break faith.
- V. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit,
- R. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

ALLELUIA – Psalm 47:9

God rules over the nations; God sits upon His holy throne.

THE GOSPEL – Matthew 24:37-44

Jesus said to his disciples: "As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. In those days before the flood. they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day that Noah entered the ark. They did not know until the flood came and carried them all away. So will it be also at the coming of the Son of Man. Two men will be out in the field: one will be taken, and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken, and one will be left. Therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come. Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour of night when the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and not let his house be broken into. So too, you also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."
