Highlights of July Meeting "Keeping <u>YOU</u> Informed of Parish Matters!"

PEST CONTROL/WOODPECKER UPDATE: The parish will have the exterior of the church and the rectory painted with a special paint to deter the on-going damage caused by woodpeckers. Met with contractor July 10. He will power wash the building. No date set. **CEMETERY NEWS:** Plans to remove the broken gate from the cemetery entrance.still on hold.

MISSION COMMISSION MAILING: The Mission Commission post card mailing to promote new members for the parish and the picnic was mailed to 50,000 households in the area. The \$19,500 cost was paid by the Enlivenment program of the Central Diocese.

Fluorescent green t-shirts are in the works for members of the church to wear at the picnic and community functions for promotion. 1

Included in this mailing is a report of each members financial contributions to the parish to date. (*According to your member #) Lynn Dowd, Financial Sec., reported that donations for the first six months are up about \$4,200 and savings on fuel oil for heating has decreased by \$5,600 this season. However, we are reminded that although dues is no longer collected, members need to increase weekly donations to cover the difference in expenses. To date, parish expenses vs. income shows a net loss of \$34,228.65. Thank you for your support for our parish!
